Upon paying admission and gaining entry to the school, all students are subject to the supervision and direction of adult
chaperones. The chaperones are the approved supervisors of all events and act in place of parents. Students who sign in
guests are responsible for their guest's behavior during attendance at the event.

### **Dress Code:**

## The following are prohibited:

- ★ Sleeveless shirts
- ★ Obscene or derogatory messages
- ★ Hats or caps
- ★ Skirts / dresses shorter than 2" above the knee
- ★ Spaghetti straps without a shirt with sleeves
- ★ Strapless, tube tops or low cut tops
- ★ Dresses, skirts and blouses that expose the midriff, the back or cleavage
- ★ Visible undergarments

#### **Code of Conduct**

- No aggressive behavior
- No pushing or running
- Keep your hands to yourself.
- No inappropriate dancing.
- Purses, bags and jackets will be turned into the check-in room where items will be monitored and returned at the end of the dance.
- At dances, parents may not leave children unattended until the doors open at 7:00pm.
- Upon arrival, all students and their guests must sign in at the entrance.

- Parents must sign their child/children out at the end of the dance.
- Parents must come to the gymnasium at the end of the dance to pick up their child/children. Children may not leave unattended.
- Internet posting of ANY pictures or negative messages about St. Aloysius students or events without permission is a violation of the school's technology policies and any violations will be handled by the Principal and Pastor.
- Drinks of any kind are strictly prohibited in the Gym.

#### **Consequences of Misconduct**

Any dance / event attendee who disobeys the set rules may be removed from the dance / event by a chaperone. The offender will be closely supervised while a parent or guardian is contacted. The offender will then be escorted off the premises into the charge of the parent or guardian. If criminal offenses are detected, the Pottsgrove Police will be notified and will handle the violation(s).

Any dance / event attendee who disobeys the Code of Conduct may be banned from further attendance at any future events.
